
CHILDCARE TEAM



I. We can't be like JESUS without it

³⁴When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things.

Academy Class: God and Politics

taught by Dr. Jeff Stivason, Pastor of Grace Reformed Presbyterian Church

Alexander Solzhenitsyn was a victim of Soviet totalitarianism. He spent years in the Russian gulag before he was ejected from his country. When he was asked why things in Russia were as they were, his response was simple, "Men have forgotten God." He believed the core crisis that created and sustained communism was not political but spiritual. The core of the crisis in our own nation is not political but spiritual. And yet, the Bible speaks to us about the political realm. This class will look at a variety of passages as we think through what God has to say about politics.

BREATHE after-abortion care participants can expect a warm and confidential environment among others who care and understand. Using the book, Where Do Broken Hearts Go?, group members will be encouraged to examine the past and understand how abortion has affected their lives. In addition, attendees will be given the support needed to explore difficult emotions, and together, we will find the courage to more fully embrace the healing and transformative hope of Christ.

Our instructor, Jessica Patterson, understands firsthand the importance of after-abortion healing. For over a decade, she struggled with bitter justification of her own abortion at 22 years old. When confronted with the invitation to attend an abortion healing group, although intrigued, she admits she wrestled with fear of judgment. After agreeing to attend, she quickly came to a new understanding that her past did not define her and that God not only had forgiven her, but desired to heal and transform her.
