Our Middle School and High School Ministry strives to provide a fun, high-energy, relevant, and Bible-centered environment where our students can grow and mature in their faith. Student Ministries meets during all weekend services at The Warehouse and features worship, teaching, age/gender-based small groups, and much more. The Warehouse is located across the street on Boyd Road.

WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

We meet on Wednesday nights (7-8:15 p.m.), but not for worship services like we do on the weekends. For adults, we offer academic-level Academy classes that run for six consecutive weeks. Topics range from basic Bible truths to emotional wholeness; from in-depth Bible study to practical parenting or financial assistance. We also offer kids' and students' programs (birth - grade 12) for fun, friendship, learning, and growth. All Wednesday night programs require registration and meet during the school year from September - May.

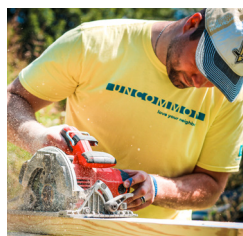
STUDENTS ARE BACK FROM THEIR MISSION TRIPS!

A Forgiving Heart

Just Like Jesus | Week 3
July 2 & 3, 2022

I. What is Forgiveness?

- A. Definition: to let go, give up a debt, to remit, give up, and keep no longer.
- B. Two senses of forgiveness:
 - 1. Context of Salvation –
 - 2. Interpersonal sense –
- C. Forgiveness is linked with repentance (Luke 24:46-47, Acts 2:38, Acts 3:19)

II. The Lord's Prayer: Instruction on How to Pray.

Our Father in Heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. (Matthew 6:9-12)

- A. For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
(Galatians 3:26 NASB 1995)
 - 1. We become "sons" through the forgiveness of God.
- B. Two senses of the Kingdom – Present and Future
(Matthew 13:31-32, Revelation 20:4)

III. Steps to Walk in Forgiveness:

- 1. Be reconciled to God
- 2. Know what God's will is (Matthew 6:11-12, 6:14, Ephesians 4:31-32)
- 3. Be mindful of your sin (Romans 12:3)
- 4. Forgiveness has a supernatural element (Philippians 2:13)
