Our Cornerstone Kids (birth - grade 5) can enjoy fun, safe, Bible-based, and kids'-style classes and activities in our brightly colored Children's Ministry Wing. All children should report to the elementary wing for their weekend classes. Our Middle School and High School Ministry strives to provide a fun, high-energy, relevant, and Bible-centered environment where our students can grow and mature in their faith. Student Ministries meets during all weekend services at The Warehouse and features worship, teaching, age/gender-based small groups, and much more. The Warehouse is located across the street on Boyd Road.

WEDNESDAY NIGHTS

We meet on Wednesday nights (7-8:15 p.m.), but not for worship services like we do on the weekends. For adults, we offer academic-level Academy classes that run for six consecutive weeks. Topics range from basic Bible truths to emotional wholeness; from in-depth Bible study to practical parenting or financial assistance. We also offer kids' and students' programs (birth - grade 12) for fun, friendship, learning, and growth. All Wednesday night programs require registration and meet during the school year from September - May.

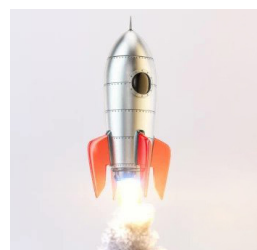
BABY DEDICATION
