SCRIPTURAL AFFIRMATIONS

I recognize that there is only one true and living God (Ex. 20:2-3) who exists as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and who is worthy of all honor, praise, and glory as the Beginning and the End of all things (Rev. 4:11; 5:9-10; Is. 43:1, 7, 21).

I recognize Jesus Christ as the Messiah, the Word who became flesh and lived among us (John 1:1, 14). I believe He came to destroy the works of the enemy (1 John 3:8), and defeated him on the cross.

I believe that God has proven His love for me because, when I was still a sinner, Christ died for me (Rom. 5:8). I believe that He delivered me from darkness and transferred me into His kingdom, and in Him I am restored and have been forgiven (Col. 1:13-14).

I believe that I am now a child of God (1 John 3:1-3) and have a place with Christ in heaven (Eph. 2:6). I believe that I was saved by grace through faith, that it was a gift, and not the result of any work on my part (Eph. 2:8-9).

I choose to be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power (Eph. 6:10). I put on the whole armor of God, and I am determined to stand firm in my faith (Eph. 6:11-20).

I believe that apart from Christ I can do nothing (John 15:5), so I declare myself dependent on Him. I choose to abide in Christ in order to produce fruit as His disciple, recognizing this will give God great glory (John 15:8).



I believe that the truth will set me free (John 8:32), and I choose to walk in the light (1 John 1:7) by taking every thought captive in obedience to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5). I declare that the Bible is the foundation of my faith (2 Tim. 3:15-16), and I choose to speak the truth in love (Eph. 4:15).

I choose to give myself as a living sacrifice and commit to renewing my mind by God's Word in order to understand His good, pleasing, and perfect will for my life (Rom. 6:13; 12:1-2). As a result, I leave my old nature behind and instead live by my new nature (Col. 3:9-10), for I am a new person in Christ (2 Cor. 5:17).

I trust my Heavenly Father to fill me with His Spirit (Eph. 5:18), to guide me into all truth (John 16:13), and to empower my life that I may live above sin and not carry out my selfish desires (Gal. 5:16). In fact, I nailed my sinful desires to the cross and crucified them there (Gal. 5:24).

I reject all selfish goals and choose the ultimate goal of love (1 Tim. 1:5). I choose to obey the two greatest commandments; to love the Lord my God with all my heart, soul, and mind, and to love my neighbor as myself (Matt. 22:37-39).

I believe that Jesus has all authority in heaven and on earth (Matt. 28:18) and that He is the head over every ruler and authority (Col. 2:10). Ultimately, I recognize that the power that raised Christ from the dead and seated Him in the place of honor at God's right hand is the same power that is found within me (Eph. 1:19-23).

So I know I am God's masterpiece, who was created to do the great things He planned for me to accomplish before time began (Eph. 2:10).
